



Election of Chairman and Vice Chairman

To avoid unnecessary discussion at the Town Forum meeting 28th October 2010 members should be aware of the following:

1.
Members do not have a right to know who has been nominated for election prior to the day as per all previous five elections. The nominations are collected by the Secretary and Community Champion.
2.
Each nomination will be announced at the election meeting and also be as per all previous five elections.
3.
Since the beginning of the Town Forum and as per previous five elections - nominees, nominators and seconders do not address the Town Forum before the voting.
4.
As per previous five elections voting has to be in person at the meeting by a show of hands. No proxy voting and no transferable votes.
5.
Each Ward Councillor of Royal Tunbridge Wells, the unparished area of the Borough of Tunbridge Wells, has a single vote as he/she is the appointed representative of their constituents (8 Wards - 21 Councillors).
6.
Each voting representative (i.e. appointed representative who was chosen to be entitled to vote) of each accredited member/membership organisation has a single vote. But no person, for purposes of the election, may represent more than one accredited membership organisation.
7.
Membership, including the appointed representative entitled to vote on its behalf, is, up to and including the 30th September 2010 meeting following approval of the minutes of the 30th September 2010 meeting at the 28th October 2010 meeting.
8.
Voting cards will be issued to each appointed representative entitled to vote.
