He will also tell us about the rebuilding of the city and the Frauenkirche and express his belief in the city's bright cultural future - despite its loss of World Heritage status.

A special guest this evening will be Masha Davies (née Obolenskaya) of Lamberhurst, who, as an eleven year-old girl, lived through the inferno of the bombing raids on Dresden and will tell us of "The night my childhood came to an end".
