Tunbridge Wells and Wiesbaden first created the bond of friendship in 1960, but it was 1989 when the official charter was signed by the then mayors of both towns. A series of events will be taking place for which the *Oberbürgermeister* (Lord Mayor) and other dignitaries are travelling from Wiesbaden to take part in the official celebratory ceremonies in our town. Accompanying them will be the thirty-strong Wiesbaden Symphonic Brass Ensemble, which will give two concerts, one free in the Pantiles at 3pm on 22nd May and another, together with choirs from local schools, in St. John's Church at 7.30pm on 23rd May, for which tickets are on sale. Tunbridge Wells own Bloco Fogo Samba Band will also be staging a free concert on the lawns outside St. John's Church from 7pm on 23rd May. From July exhibitions will be on display in the Town Hall and at Tunbridge Wells Library.
